Chair Campbell called the meeting to order and determined a quorum.

**1. Consider minutes of the April 22, 2019 meeting**

The minutes of the Murfreesboro Cable Television Commission meeting held on April 22, 2019 were presented for approval.

**Dr. Heinrich made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Lindsey. The motion passed.**

**2. Hear from Comcast regarding the 2018 Year End Annual Report.** Ms. Kim Sasser Hayden passed out some additional information regarding the annual report and went over Comcast highlights over the past year. Comcast has around 29,000 video subscribers in Murfreesboro. Last year paid \$1.4 million in franchise fees to the City. Comcast continues to invest capital money to improve the network and innovate services. Over 100 employees work in Murfreesboro. Continue to improve customer service, narrowed scheduled appointments with two-hour windows now. Communicating new ways with customers with My Account. Improving reductions in calls to call center and fixing issues on first contact with Comcast. Chair Campbell thanked Ms. Hayden for providing the report and going over the previous year activities.

### **3. Staff Reports and Other Business**

Mr. Bozeman reported that the all Comcast complaints received have been addressed by Comcast or by staff. Mr. Bozeman provide a breakdown of all the Comcast Cable Television complaints recieved by the city during 2018 with the majority of those being billing issues. Mr. Bozeman discussed some of the most recent CityTV programming live coverage which included MFRD New Recruits Graduation, Uncle Dave Macon Days Press Conference, Murfreesboro Peace Officer Memorial, and promoted International Folkfest and Juneteenth Celebration at Bradley Museum, next month live on locations programming includes promoting the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration Under the Stars and coverage of National Night Out.

He stated this month on Storytellers with John Hood they visited with the Gina Foster Cannon, Director of Cultural and Heritage Tourism and on the In the City program features include: the season opening of Miracle League, City School Drone Program, a look at the progress on Salem Elementary, Coffee with a Cop program, Downtown Square and Rutherford County Farmers Market, Movies Under The Stars, opening weekend of Boro Beach.

There being no other business to come before the Commission, Chair Campbell declared the meeting adjourned.

**RE: Podcasts**

As an item for the agenda of March 2, 2020, information on a new podcast service available by the City.

**Background**

Discussions were held by Communications department staff and Public Information Director Mike Browning in 2019 about the idea of producing podcasts for the City. In January 2020, Rover, the city's transit system, announced they would be implementing changes to their bus routes and schedules. The decision was made this would be the perfect opportunity to produce a pilot episode on the subject. To maximize the opportunity, CityTV also video recorded the podcast for air on CityTV as well as for social media.

The audio of the podcast can be heard on Podbean, a hosting site for podcasts nationally. City podcasts can be found by clicking on the Media Center logo on the city home page at [www.murfreesborotn.gov](http://www.murfreesborotn.gov) or directly at the Podbean located at <https://cityofmurfreesborotn.podbean.com/>. Over time we will look at additional sites like Spotify and iTunes. The video podcast called "The Insider" began airing in late January on CityTV, Facebook and YouTube.

The second podcast with guest Greg McKnight, interim Planning Director, will debut in March. The overall goal is to initially create new podcasts once a month. If the demand is there and content available, CityTV would produce additional podcasts as needed.

**Fiscal Impact**

The cost for the hosting service, Podbean, is \$108.00 annually.
