'In the City' highlights Chrisman, Richardson retirements, Bookmobile

MURFREESBORO, Tenn. – The January 2016 episode of “In the City,” Murfreesboro’s video magazine show hosted by Cecilia Herrell, honors two long-time City employees for decades of service to the citizens of Murfreesboro.

Murfreesboro Police Chief Glenn Chrisman retired at the end of December after 40 years of service in law enforcement. Transportation Director Dana Richardson retires January 14, 2016, after 31 years dedicated to traffic control and highway development in Murfreesboro.
