National Public Safety Telecommunications Week Ceremony

The Murfreesboro Police Department, Murfreesboro Fire and Rescue Department, and the City of Murfreesboro will honor local public safety Telecommunicators, the “first” first responders, this week in honor of National Telecommunicators Week.
