

RESOLUTION 22-R-06 authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds by the City of Murfreesboro, Tennessee, of not to exceed fifty-seven million dollars (\$57,000,000) to provide funding for certain public works projects, and to fund the incidental and necessary expenses related thereto.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the public interest of the City of Murfreesboro, Tennessee (the "Municipality") to issue one or more series of general obligation bonds (the "Bonds") pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 21, Tennessee Code Annotated (the "Act"), for the purpose of financing certain public works projects, as hereinafter more fully described, and to pay legal, fiscal, administrative, architectural, and engineering costs, and costs incident to the financing of such public works projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MURFREESBORO, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. For the purposes of financing (a) all or a portion of the costs of certain public works projects, consisting of the acquisition, construction, improvement, extension, and renovation of the following: (1) public lands, buildings, facilities and related equipment, (2) airport terminals, roadways, facilities and related equipment, (3) fire and rescue buildings, facilities, vehicles, and related equipment, (4) police buildings, facilities, vehicles and related equipment, (5) parks and recreation buildings, facilities, vehicles and related equipment, (6) public golf buildings, facilities, vehicles and related equipment, (7) solid waste buildings, facilities, vehicles and related equipment, (8) streets, roads, bridges, plazas, sidewalks, lighting, drainage, streetscapes, signage and related department buildings, facilities, vehicles and equipment, (9) municipal vehicles, and (10) communication, software and technology improvements related to or in connection with the foregoing public works projects; (b) acquisition, construction and improvement of all other property, real and personal, appurtenant thereto or connected therewith, including but not limited to all utilities and infrastructure related to the foregoing public works projects; (c) all legal, fiscal, administrative, architectural, and engineering costs incident thereto; (d) reimbursement, if any, for prior expenditures for any and all of the foregoing; and (e) costs incident to issuing the Bonds, the Municipality is hereby authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the amount of not to exceed fifty-seven million dollars (\$57,000,000), which shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed the maximum rate permitted under applicable Tennessee law.

SECTION 2. The Bonds shall be payable from unlimited ad valorem taxes to be levied for such purpose on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Municipality, without limitation as to time, rate, and amount and, for the punctual payment of said principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the Bonds, the full

faith and credit of the Municipality will be irrevocably pledged. In addition, the Bonds may be payable from any and all legally available funds of the Municipality.

SECTION 3. After the adoption of this Resolution, the City Recorder is directed to cause this Resolution, with the notice prescribed by the Act, to be published in full once in a newspaper published and having general circulation in the Municipality.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Municipality requiring it.
