

2016-2018 DBE Goal

The Federal Transit Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 26 requires the establishment of an overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal for Federal Fiscal Years 2016-2018. DBE goals are set to enhance participation by minority, women's and small businesses in federally funded contracts. Types of items procured with federal Transit Administration USC 5307 funding are: Bus Washing Services, Janitorial Supplies, Uniforms, Office Supplies, Signage, Communication Services, Marketing, Construction, Architectural and Engineering, etc. All qualified DBE's must be registered with and approved by the State of Tennessee Department of Transportation Unified Certification Program (UCP). The overall DBE goal for Rover Public Transportation has been set at 6.0% with a race-neutral / race-conscience split of 3%/3% DBE participation on all Rover Public Transportation contracts utilizing Federal USDOT grant funding over \$250,000.00.
